

## **Apprentice Wage Rates**

## National Minimum Wage and National Living Wage rates from the 1st April 2022

Apprentices *	£4.81 per hour
Workers aged under 18	£4.81 per hour
Workers aged 18 – 20	£6.83 per hour
Workers aged 21 – 22	£9.18 per hour
Workers aged 23 and over (national living wage)	£9.50 per hour

\* The minimum apprentice rate of £4.81 per hour applies to:

- apprentices aged under 19
- apprentices aged 19 or over in the first year of their apprenticeship

Apprentices aged 19 or over and <u>not</u> in the first year of an apprenticeship, will be eligible for the applicable minimum wage/national living wage rate as below:

## JIB (Joint Industry Board) apprentice rates

Please note that JIB rates are optional for non-JIB registered companies and are included for reference only. From and including Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2022 the JIB hourly rates for apprentices shall be:
